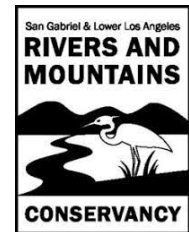


- The 2022-2023 budget committed \$1.6 billion for nature-based solutions
- The 2023-2024 budget maintains \$1.4 billion (90%) of investments
- El presupuesto 2022-2023 comprometió \$1.6 mil millones para soluciones basadas en la naturaleza
- El presupuesto 2023-2024 mantiene \$1.4 mil millones (90%) de inversiones

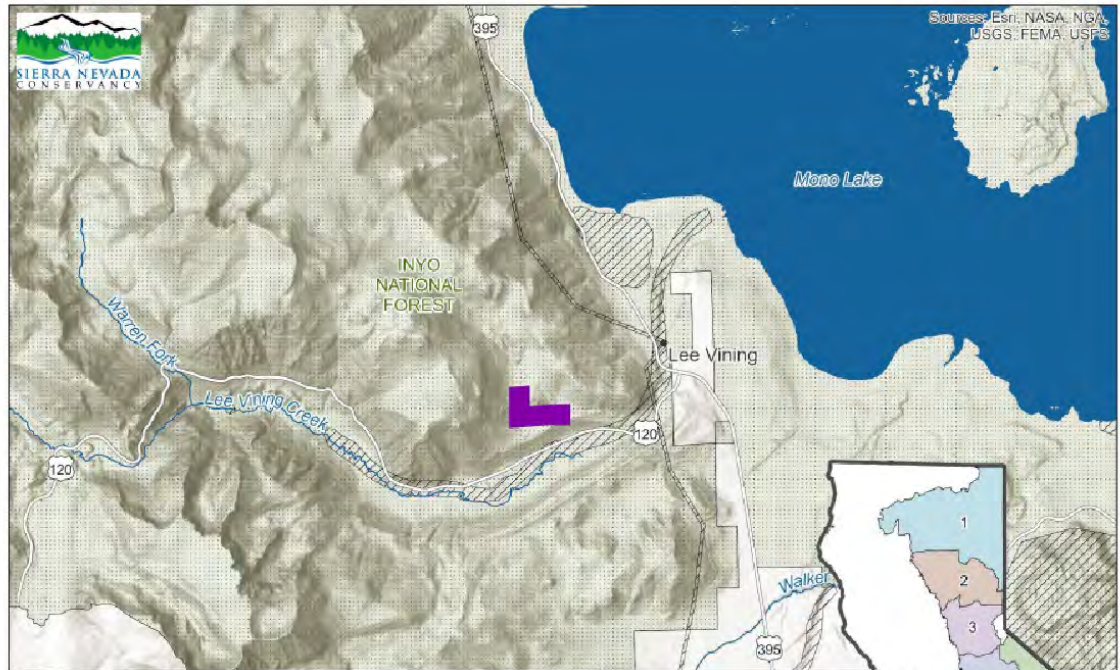

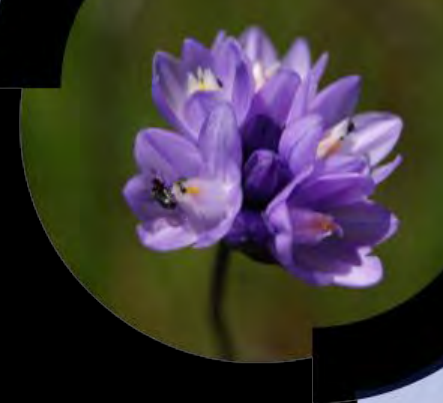
